Do you have a spare room?

If so, could you offer a home to a young person, for which you will receive £100 a week as part of our Lodgings scheme.

The Young Persons Lodging Scheme runs across the Royal Borough of Kingston Upon Thames matching host families and individuals with **young people aged 16 to 25** who need a home, but are not quite ready to live independently.

As a host, you would provide a **safe and supportive environment**, perhaps passing on practical skills such as cooking, cleaning and budgeting. You would receive **thorough training, together with ongoing support**.

Being a host is **personally rewarding** as you watch your young person **grow in confidence** and move towards independence. It can also provide a **tax free second income** under the Government's 'Rent a Room' scheme*.
